
BARBARA CARRERA


to command attention with her charisma and screen presence, solidifying her status as a notable Bond villain. She really loved filming in France and she's eager to tell you all about it.

MICHAEL RUNYARD

With a career spanning over four decades, Michael Runyard has become synonymous with breathtaking action sequences and daring stunts. One of his most notable contributions was as the stunt double for Sean Connery in *Never Say Never Again*. Specifically, Michael's mastery shines in the film's exhilarating motorbike chase scenes, where he flawlessly stepped into Connery's shoes, executing high-speed maneuvers and thrilling stunts with precision and flair. Further credits include *Octopussy* and *A View to a Kill*.



THE VENUE



La Citadelle is the cultural heart of the fishing town of Villefranche-sur-Mer. Home to the town hall, a museum and shop, this was also the site that doubled for many of the Palmyra lair scenes in *Never Say Never Again*. It was here where Bond rescued Domino just before she was sold-off.

WELCOME TO THE CÔTE D'AZUR



In 1953, it is in France that James Bond was introduced to the world. Ian Fleming's inaugural book, *Casino Royale*, saw James Bond in a fictionalised northern coastal town called Royale-les-Eaux. Fleming would ensure his hero would return to France in *On Her Majesty's Secret Service, Goldfinger, From a View to a Kill, From Russia With Love* and, obliquely, in *Thunderball*.

ANTIBES

Producers Albert R. Broccoli and Harry Saltzman were quick to realise the need for their cinematic James Bond to also grace the beautiful country in the films, *Thunderball, Diamonds are Forever, Moonraker, A View to a Kill, GoldenEye, Tomorrow Never Dies and The World is Not Enough.* Through alternate producers, Sean Connery's last Bond film, *Never Say Never Again*, visited the azure coast of the French Riviera to take in Villefranche-sur-Mer, Antibes, Menton and Monaco.

Whether it is the romance of Paris, the exquisitely beautiful châteaux, the transcendental glamour of the Côte d'Azur, the films and books capture the chic, the confidence, the magnificence of this beautiful country. The continuation authors such as Raymond Benson and Anthony Horowitz have set two of their novels in France. And further to their successes on screen, Sir Roger Moore, Sir Sean Connery and Sir David Niven all chose the Côte d'Azur as their home.

Alternatively you could choose to stay in Nice, just around the corner, where plenty of hotels in different price categories can be found.



GETTING AROUND

By far the easiest way to get to Villefranche-sur-Mer is with a (rental) car. There's a public parking next to the Citadelle. From Nice and the other towns, Villefranche-sur-Mer can also be reached by train. Do note though, that they have no night service, so do plan your return ahead.

Alternatively, you could rent a bike! Villefranche is only a 30 minute ride from Nice and it's a pretty ride along the coast.

Taxis and Ubers are also available, and when sharing make for a good & economical alternative as well.
